REFUGEES ENJOY THE SAME FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS AND. SHOULD RECEIVE THE SAME BASIC HELP AS ANYONE ELSE. THIS INCLUDES FREEDOM FROM TORTURE AND DEGRADING TREAT-MENT AS WELL AS FREEDOM FROM DISCRIMINATION. REFUGEES SMOULD ALSO HAVE ACCESS TO MEDICAL CARE, THE RIGHT TO GO TO SCHOOL AND THE RIGHT TO WORK IN THE COUNTRY OF ASYLUM.


